Police offer £50,000 reward for information leading to Lord Alford's killer.



Police have offered a five figure sum for information which leads them to identify the ruthless killer who is responsible for the grisly murder of Lord Ian Alford.

Alford's body was discovered in the

early hours of yesterday morning by his housekeeper, Mrs. Baker.

Mrs. Baker reported that she thought she had heard an intruder moving about in the grounds of the Manor House at around nine o'clock on Tuesday evening.

Lord Alford has apparently infuriated several of his workers recently when he refused to allow any holidays to be taken over the festive season.

Mrs. Baker, who has been in service

Saturday 23rd December

at the Manor House since 1987 - and has recently nursed Alford back to health after his recent hip replacement operation - was visibly distressed after she made the gruesome discovery.

"I can't imagine who would want to harm the Master", she is reported to have said when interviewed at length by detectives from Gloucester.
