highlight

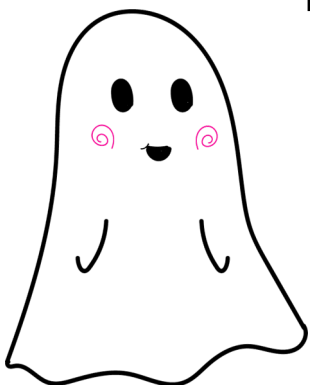
find
